The Northern Port in Gdańsk

The rapid growth of Polish foreign trade turnovers was the main reason of building a new port for the transshipment of bulk cargo in Gdańsk. The article discusses the location of the port, three of its reloading bases for coal, oil and oil products and ores, characterizes the scope of this investment project and the new technical solutions applied in the construction of the port.

Agricultural jet aircraft

Poland's extensive programme of crop spraying services provided to many countries of the world is based on a domestic production of agricultural aircraft. The newest design of such aircraft (M15) has been developed jointly with the U.S.S.R. The M15 is an all-metal, two-boom sesquiplane with a short fuselage and a turbo-jet engine. The tanks for chemical stuff have been mounted in a special structure between the airfoils. The aircraft can operate from air fields and features a very high output capacity.
