

The main achievement of 1974

The Editorial Board of the PTR has interviewed a number of known economic leaders who are members of the Programme Committee of our Review asking them to describe the most important achievement of their enterprises in the past twelve months.

The issue brings statements by export department directors of the Ministries of the Engineering and of the Heavy Industries, managers of foreign trade enterprises dealing with the sales of building machinery, complete industrial plants and electric enginering.

The R-30 digital computer

The Digital Computer R-30 designed and manufactured by the Electronic Equipment Factory MERA-ELWRO in Wroclaw is part of the United Computer System (JS EMC).

R-30 is a medium-power computer whose sub-assemblies have been based on the most recent achievements of the Polish industry. The article gives a description of the machine, its peripheral equipment and of the operational system.

The Polish shipbuilding industry in 1975

Plans for the current year provide for a considerable increase of the number of ships to be launched in 1975 as well as for qualitative improvements resulting from a better adjustment of the Polish industry to changed conditions on various markets as well as new transport requirements. Polish shipyards will build as 30 types of ships, half of which are prototypes.

Among the new vessels, mention is due to Ro-Ro ships, a new type of container ships, tankers for the transport of chemicals, ships of the LPG type and seiners. The production of ships for export will grow at a particularly rapid pace. The current year will be also a period of further mode nization and extension of shipyards and plants cooperating with the shipbuilding industry. The total investment outlays earmarked for this industry in 1975 will exceed twice those of the whole five-year period 1966–1970.
