

### Machines for the building industry

Building machines are manufactured in Poland by factories affiliated with two large Unions: BUMAR and ZREMB. The current issue of the Polish Technical Review deals mostly with the activities of ZREMB. These activities are discussed by the manager-in-chief of ZREMB Mr. Jerzy Malecki in his interview for PTR. The various articles of the current issue deal with machinery for foundation works including powered undercarriages, vehicles for the transport of powdered materials, concrete and prefabricated elements. Also discussed are machines and equipment for the production of concrete, two different types of cranes, equipment for finishing works and methods of testing building machinery in Poland.
