Galvanising and painting equipment from Wieluń

Galvanising and painting equipment find application in many branches of industry: construction of motorcars, production of household articles, metal industry production, etc. Poland has one of the largest factories in Europe, producing this type of equipment on the basis of Polish concepts and foreign licences and know-how. This equipment is discussed on page 16 with special consideration of galvanising automatic installations, equipment for electrophoretic painting, spray phosphotising, tunnel dryers, washers and waste neutralisation plants.
