

Metal treatment

The present issue which appears directly before the opening of the 51 Poznań International Fair deals with an extensive range of subjects including those connected with metal treatment. For many years now, the Polish shipbuilding industry has occupied a leading place among fishing vessels manufacturers. The latest offer of this industry has been enlarged to include land-based and floating fishing units (fishing fleet, a port with technical back-up for the servicing of ships, fish storage and processing), a matter of particular interest for the developing countries. Longwall shearer-loader

An interesting achievement among mining machinery presented in the current issue is a new mining combine used for work at caving and stowing longwalls, 1.8 to 3.5 m high, in cooperation with scraper conveyors and various types of mechanized longwall supports. The combine features a number of new design solutions described in more detail in separate articles. The Polish shearer-loaders have contributed to a substantial concentration of mining and labour output growth in Polish collieries which occupy one of the leading places among world coal producers and exporters (200 million t per year).
