

#### Sailplanes from plastics

Poland has a long-standing tradition in the construction of sailplanes. Designers from the PZL-Bielsko Plant have considerable achievements in this field. Their models are being constantly improved. The planes made at PZL-Bielsko are of a laminated structure. The planes on p. 2 present two types of sailplanes — one of the standard class and the other of the open class. Both models have scored marked successes at world championships and are exported to many countries.

#### Process lines for the production of carded yarn by the spindleless method

The spindleless spinning processes concern also the area of carding spinning ensuring a high output of the process and proper utilization of the wide raw material base. The BEFAMA plant at Bielsko-Biala makes in series complete production lines for the manufacturing of carded yarn by the spindleless method. These lines are based on two machine sets: the carding set and a spindleless spinning frame. For details see article on p. 7.

#### A three-colour light-emitting diode

This diode (symbol CQVP 63) produced by the POLAM Factory in Warsaw is a novelty on a world scale. The diode enables signallization of several states by means of red, yellow or green light. It may find application as high-precision optical tuning indicators in radio sets, for indicating the temperature of motor-car coolant and also in various kinds of testers for reading the limiting values of the parameters of interest.
